### PROPERTY, WATER & BUSINESS TAX

All taxes are due by **15 April 2015**, if the payment is made **in full** by **31 March 2015** an incentive of a **10%** discount will be applied to your account. ## MANDATORY DOG REGISTRATION

This is a reminder that it is now mandatory for all residents to register their dogs for a one-time fee of \$5.00. The Animal Control Officer has commenced patrols within Bauline. If you wish to register an animal complaint please contact the town office.
