## MUNICIPAL TAXES

All Municipal Taxes should be distributed by 19 February 2016. There will be a 10% discount for those residents who pay by 31 March 2016. As well, this year any resident in receipt of a Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) may make application for a 20% discount in the municipal taxes. Please contact the Town Office for more details.

Vacant land Minimum Tax	\$575.00 (same as '15)
Business Tax	\$425.00 (same as '15)

Taxes are due by 15 April 2016

Payment by 31 March will receive 10% discount

Residents in receipt of GIS may apply for 20% discount (new)

Interest will be 2% on taxes not received by due date.

## RNC – TIP OF THE MONTH

### Stopping for Emergency Vehicles

One of the greatest difficulties for emergency response personnel is negotiating through traffic. Emergency responders observe many situations where motorists fail to follow the rules of the road when an emergency vehicle approaches them.

As an operator of a motor vehicle you should always be checking your rear view mirror and scanning well ahead of you. When you see an emergency vehicle approaching, you should activate your right indicator light, apply your brakes and slow to a stop at the right hand side of the roadway to allow the emergency vehicle to pass. Once the vehicle has passed, check to ensure that it is safe to enter back into traffic again.

Remember, always check your rear view mirror and scan well ahead, don't panic and pull to the right.
