RUMRUNNERS’ RALLY – 1-3 JULY

On July 1-3, Newfound Riders, Newfound Foundation and the Jack Byrne Arena are holding the first-ever “Rumrunners’ Rally” – a Canada Weekend series of events at the Arena oriented to motorcycles and related “experiences”: demonstrations, displays, games and vendors of all sorts, including accessories, equipment, clothing and other goods and services, as well as organized Rides throughout the region, live music on an outdoor stage and a headliner concert on Saturday July 2nd featuring three top-class groups. All are welcome to participate and tickets are available through Ticket Pro and the Jack Byrne Arena: see the following websites at www.rumrunnersrally.com and www.newfoundriders.com.

As part of the Rally, on Sunday July 3rd, in co-operation with the Towns of Torbay, Flatrock, Pouch Cove and Bauline, the Rumrunners’ Rally will be holding a Parade from the Jack Byrne Arena around the four communities of the Killick Coast that will feature an array of motorcycles and other vehicles: Targa Newfoundland will be there with its lead course car and several racers, as will local sports cars and classic/antique vehicles. There will be a luncheon stop at the Bauline Community Centre where the Community Committee will serve a traditional fishermen’s brewis or home-made baked beans/tea buns, with coffee/tea/juice and a dessert, for \$10 a head.

The Parade will start at the Jack Byrne Arena at 10:30, head north on Torbay Road, down Wind Gap Road and through Flatrock, back to Torbay Road and out to Pouch Cove. At the Pouch Cove Fire Hall, it will turn left along the Pouch Cove Line to Bauline, turning right on the Bauline Line to the wharf and then up to the new Community Centre for the lunch stop. After 45 minutes or so, the Parade will head out along the Bauline Line

to the Torbay By-Pass and into the Jack Byrne Arena sometime between 1:30 and 2:30.

All residents of Torbay, Flatrock, Pouch Cove and Bauline are encouraged to support the Parade as it passes by on Sunday July 3rd sometime between 10:30 and 1 o’clock.

TARGA NEWFOUNDLAND

TOWN OF BAULINE COMES ON BOARD FOR PROLOGUE STAGES

In early May, the town of Bauline officially signed on to become the newest town to participate in Targa Newfoundland. Bauline will replace Torbay on the Prologue Day, September 11th, prior to the start of the official first day of competition in this year’s 15th annual tarmac rally.

The town of Flatrock will also continue to host two stages on the day, with a competitor lunch being served at Cape St. Francis Elementary School, in Flatrock, in the early afternoon at the conclusion of those stages. Once the lunch is completed, competitors will then travel to the start line of the Bauline stage, which is located on the Pouch Cove Line. The stage will take competitors into Bauline and right down to the lower portion of the town where the wharf is located. The finish will be further up on the hill so competitors will park and wait at the bottom until the start of the out stage.

A lovely photo opportunity will occur with 80+ vehicles all parked within the lower area of Bauline, especially if it is a sunny day. Once all vehicles have completed the inward stage, they will line up and come back out of Bauline, returning on the same route. At the completion of that stage, competitors will then transit back to

Canadian Forces Station St. John's, where the evening car show will occur and service crews can do final preparations on the vehicles for the official first day of competition, which starts Monday, September 12th.

Grand Touring competitor and Bauline native Doug Kavanagh is thrilled to have a couple of the Prologue stages in the community for the first time this year.

"I was so glad as a competitor in Targa 2015 to represent and finish on the podium (2nd place Grand Touring, Equipped) while representing my community of Bauline," said Kavanagh. "In this year's Targa, the 15th anniversary, the competition will use the roads in our own community. World class drivers in this world class event, coming to Bauline! Thank you Bauline council for allowing the event to experience our community first hand!"

Mayor Christopher Dredge of Bauline is excited to welcome the event into the community and is looking forward to being able to promote the town to those visiting.

"The Town of Bauline is thrilled to host two of the prologue stages for Targa Newfoundland 2016, on the 15th anniversary of this world renowned event. This is an exciting opportunity for the residents of Bauline to witness world class rally racing in their very own backyard.
