FOREST FIRE SEASON

Residents, please be aware that 1 May 2016 was the start of Forest Fire Season and will continue until 15 October 2016. Although conditions may seem wet/damp, wind and dry weather allows for ground vegetation to dry quickly creating the right conditions for a fire if a source of ignition is introduced. With that said please be reminded that fires for the purpose of burning garbage, brush etc will require a free

permit to burn under the *Forestry Act*. Information regarding obtaining a fire burning permit may be directed to 729-4180 or toll-free at 1-866-709-FIRE (3473).
