

FALL CLEAN-UP

This year the Fall Clean-up will be 26-30 October 2015 and it will be curb side pick-up. Please separate your metals from bulk garbage items, and have them placed at the front of your property by Monday morning, **26 October 2015**.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Hazardous material such as paint, oil, windshield wash etc. cannot be picked up;
- Construction material will not be collected (no shingles, drywall etc.)
- No wood will be collected; if you have wooden items that you want to dispose of, bring it to the Harbour Front Quarry for the bonfire;
- No fishing nets;
- No automotive parts, tires or batteries;
- No concrete;
- No trees, soil, branches or similar yard waste

If you have questions or are not sure on an item call the Town Office.

Bonfire night will take place on its regular scheduled evening of **Thursday 5 November 2015 starting at 6:30 pm** at the Harbour Front Quarry. The Pouch Cove Volunteer Fire department will also be providing their services. Residents who have old wooden items to burn are encouraged to deposit their articles at the Harbour Front Quarry any time they wish. Please note that only wood is acceptable; no tires, plastics, metals etc. Come out and enjoy an evening of fun, music, hot chocolate and a wiener roast.
