The Bauline **"In" stage will see competitors leave from a starting point near Marine Drive Park on the Pouch Cove Line and finish at the top of the hill in Bauline**. After a short break on the wharf and around the lower part of Bauline, the Targa **"Out" stage will run from Main Street (by the mailboxes), back up the hill and to the finish at the Bauline Community Center**. There will be an opportunity to meet the drivers, see the cars and get some pictures. **There will also be a BBQ at the Community Center afterwards.**
